"CODE OF CONDUCT" FORM

As a Royal Ranger and member of Outpost 150, NJ District Royal Rangers, guided by the Royal Rangers Code and Pledge, and under the conviction of the Holy Spirit, I agree to abide by the following:

- 1. I will be respectful to all those in authority over me and obey all instructions and safety precautions given by any Commander.
- 2. I will participate in, and to the best of my ability, accomplish the tasks required for each bible lesson and skill merit taught (note: unless restricted by Parent or Guardian).
- 3. I will help when asked to assist in any set-up, take-down, loading and unloading of equipment used in any meeting, event, or outing.
- 4. I will responsibly use any equipment or facility at my disposal at any meeting, event, or outing. I will refrain from any unauthorized, damaging, or dangerous use of any equipment or facility. I will report to a Commander any equipment that I may have inadvertently or accidentally damaged. I understand that I will not be held accountable for wear out of, or accidental damage to, any equipment in my use, providing the damage was not intentional or done carelessly.
- 5. I will comply with the restrictions in the personal items list authorized for a meeting, event, or outing. (Please see Authorized Personal Equipment List for more information).
- 6. I will comply with any rules or regulations imposed by any entity providing a facility for an event or outing.
- 7. I will refrain from any bullying, harassing, assaulting of any nature, or intimidation of any other boys or Commanders at any meeting, event, or outing. If applicable, I understand that any assaults of any nature specifically outlawed by statute will be reported to the authorities.
- 8. I <u>will not</u> be disruptive or interfere with any lesson or skill merit taught during regular meetings or events.
- 9. I will not use inappropriate or profane speech.
- 10. I *will not* deface any place of meeting, event, or outing. I will not intentionally harm any animal or vegetation while in a regular meeting, event, or outing.
- 11. I <u>will not</u> leave the immediate premises of any meeting, event, or outing unless authorized to do so.
- 12. I <u>will not</u> bring alcohol, tobacco, unauthorized drugs, or pictures or videos of anything inappropriate to any meeting, event, or outing and will report any if seen.

Disciplinary Actions

Disciplinary action will be taken if any infraction of the Code of Conduct is committed. In all instances, the boy or boys involved will be given a chance to explain what happened in the event of extenuating circumstances. If these actions were justified, the infraction will be dismissed. *In general, our philosophy is to never give up on mentoring boys and trying to help them, unless they absolutely do not want to abide by the Code of Conduct and be part of Royal Rangers*.

Infractions are classified as:

1. Minor Infraction (Example: Boys being boys...arguments between boys that does not include fighting, misuse of personal items or equipment, etc.)

This will be the most common instance. When an infraction occurs, the boy or boys involved will be spoken to and, if necessary, any objects being improperly used will be confiscated until the end of the meeting, event, or outing. There will be no further ramifications and <u>no</u> record of the infraction will be kept.

- **2. Major Infraction** (Examples: Deliberate disregard for rules, obstinate behavior, fighting with other boys, etc.)
 - First Instance The boy will be spoken to, and the improper behavior discussed. A record will be kept of the occurrence.
 - > Second Instance The parents or guardians will be notified and told of the situation. A one meeting suspension may result, if agreed upon by the Commanders and the parents or guardians.
 - ➤ Third Instance Dismissal from Royal Ranger. This could be for a period of time so that help can be sought by the parents or guardians to deal with whatever issues are causing this bad behavior, or permanent, if needed. Re-entry into Royal Rangers will require Pastoral Approval and a written letter of apology from the offending boy.
- **3.** Extremely Serious Infraction (Examples: Reckless or dangerous behavior, assaults that will require notification of the authorities).
 - Dismissal from Royal Rangers and, if applicable, notification of the authorities! Infractions of a serious nature will require extensive intervention from parents or guardians. If at all advisable, returning to Royal Rangers will require any court ordered counselling or therapy, Pastoral Approval, and a written letter of apology from the offending boy. Any offended party has the right to appeal approval, meet with the Pastoral staff to convey any misgivings about the return of the offending individual, and try to work out a compromise. The courts and/or Pastoral Staff will be the final authority.

Authorized Personal Equipment List

Purpose: This list is to give specific guidelines for items which may require special precautions for the safety of all boys, Commanders, and parents that may be attending any meeting, event, or outing. This list <u>is not</u> meant to restrict the usage of other personal items which may be brought to any Ranger function. The boys are free to bring whatever personal items are needed for each meeting, event, or outing. However, if there <u>is</u> a safety concern, any items not on this list may be restricted at any time by any Commander.

Notes:

- 1. Parents or Guardians must give permission before usage of Archery or Shooting equipment. Parents or Guardians may, at their discretion, restrict their boy from any archery or shooting events that they deem inappropriate. Sufficient notice will be given before any archery or shooting event.
- 2. "*" Boy must have completed the <u>TOOL CRAFT MERIT</u> before using any pocketknives, hatchets or bow saws. All cutting at Powwows is to be done <u>only in</u> the "CUT and CHOP area" under the supervision of a Commander or designed adult.
- 3. "**" Boy must have completed the <u>FIREARM SAFETY MERIT</u> before they are allowed to do any shooting with Air Rifles/BB Guns or Firearms. All BB guns and Air Rifles brought to any meeting or outing must be unloaded and must be checked by a Commander upon arrival.

<u>Note</u>: Firearms of any type are <u>not allowed</u> at regular meetings or Powwows (unless brought by Commanders serving as firearm instructors) and can only be brought to designated shooting ranges by parents or guardians. Any firearms brought by Commanders to regular meetings for the purpose of instruction shall be unloaded and no live firearm ammunition is allowed at any regular meeting. See the Note 7 table below for the appropriate ages of shooting eligibility.

4. All Archery, BB gun, Air Rifle and Firearm shooting is done at specific ranges designed for that purpose, and that comply with all NJ state laws. All of the shooting activities are done under the supervision of a Commander specifically trained to supervise each type of shooting.

<u>Note</u>: There are no merits or events requiring the use of pistols or revolvers. They **are prohibited** from all meetings, events, or outings.

- 5. Boys found using any of the listed items in an unsafe manner will have them confiscated and they will only be returned to a Parent or Guardian.
- 6. Cell phones are allowed, but must not be in use during regular meetings, unless their use is needed in an emergency.
- 7. The below table summarizes what the three (3) Ranger age groups are allowed to use at Outpost 150, providing all required conditions listed above are met and they have their Parent or Guardian's permission.
